


Tanda, Zuri's mum, trumpeted very loud to ask everyone for help to find her little daughter.









Zuri was rehabilitating for a long time. She remained lame in her right front leg and due to her burns she wasn't grey anymore but pinkish.








When she felt better she began to think what to do to enjoy without endanger anyone, and she had a brilliant idea.

- They cover themselves with mud to protect their skin from the sun.


CURIOSITIES OF THE ELEPHANTS


STRONG - GENTLE: elephants can pull up a tree with their trunk, but they are also able to pick a flower with it.







GUIDE FOR PARENTS AND CARERS BEHAVIOURS AND ABILITIES THAT CAN BE WORKED WITH THIS STORY:



- •TO LEARN FROM ERRORS: from an unpleasant experience, it is possible to get learning, trying to be optimistic.
- •TO REDIRECT CONDUCTS: when something goes wrong, adults can share their own experiences to guide the youngest, that way, we can get generational proximity to them and we can add first-hand value to their knowledge and education.
- •TO PROVIDE SUPPORT IN THE WORST TIMES: not to quit and overcome adversity, take care of self-esteem without feeling guilty if we make a mistake, assume the consequences, learn from the experience and keep going.
- •TO DISCOVER YOUR PASSION: each one of us have something that thrill and fascinate us, Zuri had a passion for music, when she realized about it, she recovered her hope.
- •TO HELP AND TO ASK FOR HELP: it is important to have supports and to turn to them if it's needed, the characters of our story don't doubt asking for help and they got good results thank to that exchange and collaboration.
- •TO LIVE WITH A SPECIAL NEED: the main character of our story was injured and she had to learn how to live with her new deficiency.
- •TO VALUE THE POSITIVE of our personal characteristics: as the elephants, (pg. 23) each one of us have qualities that identify us and it's up to us to find the virtue in them, instead of the fault.
- •TO APPRECIATE YOUR FAMILY AND FRIENDS: they are our main support, so it is important to care for our friends and to care for the members of "our herd".
- •TO INTERACT WITH THE STORY: the tale mixes fantasy with reality including vocabulary and activities to provide not only with learning but with creativity.
